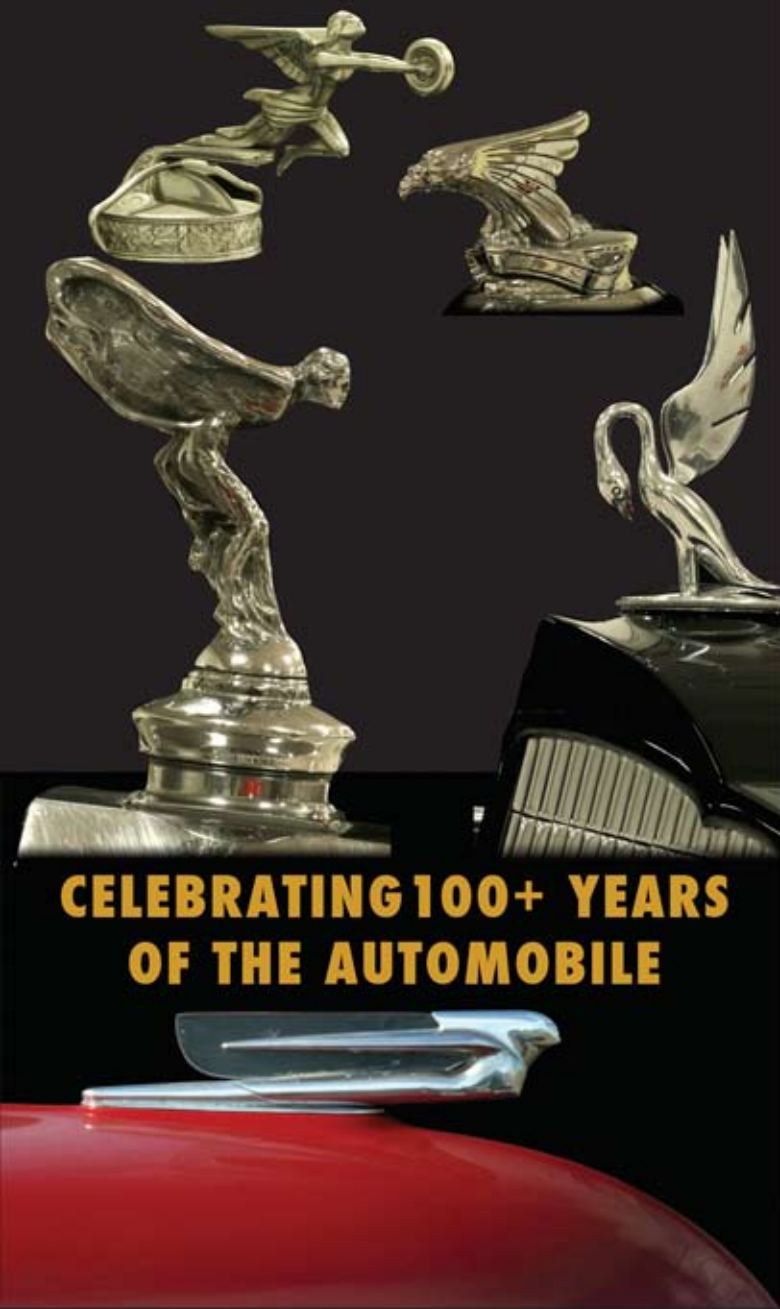

Make the Murphy Auto Museum your next stop when you want to relive automotive history! Viewing our collection of over 40 automobiles will transport you to another era. Car lovers, artists, historians, young & old will delight in taking a look at these vehicles passed through the generations.

The Murphy Auto Museum was founded in 2002 when Dan Murphy retired from his neurosurgery practice in Ventura and then formed a non-profit museum open to the public on Palma Drive in Ventura. Following three years there, the collection was moved to its current location, a much larger facility at 2230 Statham Blvd. in Oxnard, California.



The Murphy Auto Museum began its collection as American classic automobiles with an emphasis on the Packard. The Museum has now evolved to include the display of automobiles that date as early as the 1903 Oldmobile, through the Brass Era, Pre- and Post-War periods, and into the era of the Muscle Car.
